c. New vehicles, not registered with any other registration authority. Allocation certificate (retained by VLO) showing the dealer's stamp and signature & Certificate of Conformity (CoC). Where an allocation certificate is not issued e.g. for a new caravan or trailer the official bill of sale giving full chassis no (normally 17 digits) and new owners name.

d. VLO registration card (Form 73(A))

e. Bill of sale and one of above (a - d)

2. Proof of Insurance

a. BRITISH – Green card or insurance policy and schedule & current renewal receipt or cover note. All documents must be valid for Germany and specific to the vehicle being registered.

b. GERMAN – Double or single white card or copy of insurance policy. Insurance provider must be aware vehicle will be VLO registered.

3. Roadworthiness Inspection Report

Main inspection (Hauptuntersuchung) and emissions test (Abgasuntersuchung) certificate (if the vehicle is over 3 years old).

4. Confirmation of Vehicle Type Approval

(Required for all vehicles under 10 years old, except caravans, trailers & off-road.) – Certificate of Conformity for motorised vehicles or an official document (this could be the logbook, or allocation certificate) showing an EC or GB type approval number, or a UK Single Vehicle Type Approval Certificate, or German Gutachten.

5. European Highway Code (Matrix) test certificate.
